

Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc. Minutes of the Regular Meeting April 22, 2021 Greenville, IL

Call to Order and Roll Call

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc. was held on Thursday, April 22, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at the office of Southwestern Electric Cooperative headquarters in Greenville, IL pursuant to notice given. President Ann Schwarm called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.
